MARLIES RETURN TO UPSTATE NEW YORK AND ATTEMPT TO KEEP PLAYOFF HOPES ALIVE ON WEDNESDAY NIGHT AT BLUE CROSS ARENA IN ROCHESTER – HOST HAMILTON FOR FINAL TIME SUNDAY

THE OPPONENTS:

ROCHESTER AMERICANS



The Marlies attempt to keep their post-season hopes alive when they play their third game in eight days at Rochester, New York's Blue Cross Arena on Wednesday evening, opposing the Americans – AHL affiliate of the Buffalo Sabres & Florida Panthers – at 7:05 p.m. After winning one of two games versus the Amerks in upstate NY last week, the Marlies need one win in their last two games versus Rochester in order to win the season series. Toronto is 7-3-0-0 in their last 10 games and trails fourth place by Grand Rapids by 13 points in the chase for the North Division's final playoff spot. After winning three of four games last week (5-4 at Rochester Wednesday, 2-1 SO at Syracuse Saturday, and 4-1 at Hamilton on Sunday), the Marlies have moved above the .500 mark and currently have a 17-16-0-3 record

away from Ricoh Coliseum this season. The Americans, 43-29-1-0, sit one point behind the second place Bulldogs in the race for home-ice advantage through the Calder Cup Playoffs' opening round. Toronto's Robbie Earl opened the scoring with a shorthanded tally last Friday evening, but the Americans scored all three of the game's third period goals to emerge with a 5-2 victory when last these teams opposed one another. Rochester fell by a 7-4 score the following evening at Copps Coliseum and has not played since. Wednesday's contest will mark their third consecutive home game against the Marlies. (RW) Mark Mancari leads the Americans in scoring with 53 points through 73 games (21g-32a= 53 pts) and has played in 57 of the team's games to date. (LW) Michael Ryan leads the team in goals with 22. (G) David Shantz earned his first professional victory in last Friday's win over the Marlies and has a record of 1-1 while maintaining a GAA of 4.51 and a 0.880 save percentage through two appearances with the club.

Notables: Last Friday's game featured a total of 110 penalty minutes. Each club had 55 apiece. The first and third period of that game featured eight total penalty minutes combined while the second period saw six fighting majors handed-out (in addition to a number of other infractions). The Amerks are one of two AHL clubs not to have lost in a shootout this season. Hartford is the other. Toronto leads the 10-game regular season series with a record of 4-3-1. They sport a 4-4 lifetime record at Blue Cross Arena, where they set last season's high of 89 penalty minutes in their first game of the 2005-06 campaign.

GRAND RAPIDS GRIFFINS



The Marlies are in western Michigan for the final time this season when they battle the Grand Rapids Griffins – AHL affiliate of the Detroit Red Wings – on Friday night at Van Andel Arena. The Griffins, 35-27-6-5, begin week's play when they visit the Syracuse Crunch on Wednesday evening, needing a win to eliminate both the Marlies and the Crunch from post-season contention. Should the Griffins earn one point (or less) at Oncenter, Friday's game will take-on major implications for Toronto, which must defeat the Griffins on both remaining occasions to potentially overtake Grand Rapids for the North Division's final playoff spot. Grand Rapids is 21-12-2-3 on home ice this season but has earned only two of a possible six points against the Marlies in Michigan this season. After winning the first two meetings in the Bay State,

Toronto was felled by a 6-3 score on January 27 when Griffins Kip Miller (three assists) and Ryan Oulahan (one goal, two assists) had three points and a + 3 ranking to help the home side to victory. The winner of Friday's contest will also take the lead in the regular season head-to-head series as both teams have three wins through six meetings. (C) Kip Miller leads the Griffins in scoring with 68 points through 73 games (25g-43a= 68 pts) and has missed only two of his team's games to date. His 25 goals also represent a team high. (G) Stefan Liv has a record of 15-14-2, including two shutout wins, while maintaining a GAA of 2.95 and a 0.898 save percentage through 33 appearances with the club.

Notables: The Griffins continue weekend's play when they travel to Chicago on Saturday. The Marlies meet Grand Rapids in the regular season finale for both clubs on April 15 at Ricoh Coliseum. Toronto matched a season-high when they tallied three powerplay markers in a 5-3 home win when last these teams met on March 25. Marlies' goaltender Justin Pogge earned his first professional win, and first pro shutout, in a 4-0 visitors' win on October 27. The Penticton, BC native set a record by making 49 saves; the most by an opposing goalie in shutting out GR.

HAMILTON BULLDOGS



Toronto concludes their 12 game regular-season series with the provincial rival Hamilton Bulldogs – AHL affiliate of the Montreal Canadiens – on Saturday evening at Ricoh Coliseum. The Marlies emerged with a 4-1 victory, on the strength of two goals by rookie Alex Foster, when last these teams opposed one another on Sunday afternoon in the Steel City. The win marked the Marlies' fourth in six tries at Copps Coliseum this season. They held a lead in each of the six contests and currently lead the season-series with a record of 6-4-0-1. Hamilton, 40-25-3-5, will be playing their third game in three days after hosting Syracuse (on Thursday) and playing at Rochester (on Friday). As week's play begins, they sit one point ahead of the Americans with 88 points but trail first place Manitoba by eight points with seven games remaining. The Bulldogs are 17-13-2-4 away from home but have only scored one more goal (95) than they have allowed (94) when wearing dark jerseys this year. They have however won three of five meetings (while accruing seven of 10 possible points) at Ricoh Coliseum. Having recorded a goal and an assist in last Saturday's 7-4 home win over the Amerks, (C) Mikhail Grabovski has tied (RW) Duncan Milroy for the Hamilton lead in scoring with 54 points through 73 games (17g-37a= 54 pts)/(23g-31a= 54 pts). Milroy's 23 goals and Grabovski's 37 assists also represent team highs. (G) Yann Danis has a record of 21-12-4 while maintaining a GAA of 2.85 and a 0.903 save percentage through a team-high 39 appearances with the club this season.

Notables: Toronto leads the all-time series with a record of 13-9-0-1 through 23 meetings. Each team has won once via the shootout in the Steel City, while Toronto has won the lone post-OT contest in the Big Smoke. After Sunday's game, the Bulldogs will oppose the Griffins three straight times (Wednesday and Friday at Copps, Saturday in Michigan) before concluding the regular-season campaign at Rochester, a likely first round playoff opponent, on Sunday.

CCM/VECTOR AHL PLAYER OF THE WEEK NOMINEE

For the week ending April 1st, 2007, the Toronto Marlies have nominated left wing Colin Murphy for the CCM/Vector AHL Player of the Week award. A native of Fort McMurray, Alberta, Murphy scored the game winning goal and his second of the evening, in Wednesday's 5-4 win at Rochester. He had two assists, including one on the game-winner (a powerplay tally) in Sunday's 4-1 win at Copps Coliseum in Hamilton. This week's award was ultimately won by Portland's David McKee.
